Please find attached the entry form for the Croatian Junior Open 2019 that will be held in Zagreb from the **26 – 28 April**.

The following guidelines apply for entering the tournament :

All categories have a maximum draw of 32 players.

- Entries can only be made by the Member National Association. Entries from countries not associated with the ESF will have to provide a contact person from their Official Federation. That person will have to take responsibility for all entries from that country.
- All players will stay at the tournament hotel, Hotel Sliško, <u>www.slisko.hr</u>
- Due to the new Hotel policy, we can guarantee accommodation the latest on 31.03.2019. with both payed package fee. After that date, if there will be free rooms, accommodation can be made.
- Entries can only be made via email <u>davor@squashtower.hr</u>
- All players will have to wear approved protective eye guards.
- Closing date is 31th March 2019.

The tournament will start at 10:00h on Friday 26th, all participants must be at the venue at this time.

CATEGORIES

Boys and Girls under 13, 15, 17 and 19. Players are only allowed to enter one category. Maximum 32 - draws will be organised. All players are guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches

ELIGIBILITY

The Croatian Junior Open is open to all players under the age of 13, 15, 17 and 19 on the 28th of April, as appropriate. The recording of matches for coaching / performance analysis purposes is acceptable provided the player and / or their parents / coaches do not object.

SEEDING

The seeding will be carried out using the European Junior Ranking valid at the closing date.



Any non-European players without an ESF Junior Ranking will be seeded by the Tournament Director.

MATCHES

All matches played will consist of the best of five sets under the rules of the WSF. The Tournament Organisers reserve the right to organize plate matches consisting of the best of three sets.

Scoring will be to PAR 11 to 2 clear points.

REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded in all categories.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF will accept responsibility for injury arising from participating in the tournament. Suitable insurance must be organised by the player or the participating federation. All players have to wear approved protective eye guards on court.

SAFEGUARDING, HEALTH AND SAFETY

Adults interacting with juniors in the organisation and running of ESF Junior Circuit events are in a position of trust and influence. They should always ensure that junior players are treated with integrity and respect. Tournaments should be run in a safe, positive and encouraging atmosphere. The Tournament Director and Tournament Referee should be trained in safeguarding children according to the host MNF national standards for child protection.

The health and safety of all persons (players, officials, spectators, tournament staff) involved in or attending a tournament is of paramount importance. The host MNF is responsible for ensuring an appropriate plan is in place for the tournament.



EYE GUARDS

Eye guards needs to be as per WSF guidelines: All junior players (under 19 years of age) must wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play. The list of WSF Certified Eyewear allowable at the time of participation can be viewed on the WSF website.

PRIVACY POLICY

The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in ESF Regulations: Code of Conduct - The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in EUROPEAN SQUASH FEDERATION PRIVACY POLICY as published on the ESF website <u>www.europeansquash.com</u>

EUROPEAN SQUASH ID (ESID)

All players, coaches, managers and other officials must be registered with ESF. This must be approved and validated by the relevant MNF. The MNF is responsible for ensuring that all players, coaches, managers and other officials are registered with ESF prior to entry, and their entry is fully supported.

COACHES

All team or individual player coaches designated by their nation as part of their event onsite management team (solely, or in attendance with an appointed team manager) at any Championship held under the auspices of ESF must be ESF Registered i.e. have a ESF European Squash ID as their licence to attend in a formal representative role. This is required at the time of them being registered to attend by their national federation

GUIDELINES

The event complies with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website <u>www.europeansquash.com</u>; all participating MNAs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

ENTRIES

All entries must be made through / endorsed by a player's national association. Any entry not approved by the player's national association will not be accepted.



No individual entries will be accepted

DRAWS

The seeding will be circulated to all players or their national associations by e-mail. Times of first matches will be indicated for their respective players.

ENTRY FEE

Tournament package 1 : **50,00€** per person includes entry fee + Player pack (t-shirt...)

Tournament package 2: **200,00€** per person includes entry fee, 2 nights (Friday-Sunday) bed and breakfast accommodation in double/triple rooms, 5 meals at the Club (lunch Friday – lunch Sunday), transportation between arrival/departure point and hotel + Player pack (t-shirt...)

Tournament package 3: **170,00€** per person, 2 nights (Friday-Sunday) bed and breakfast accommodation in double/triple rooms, 5 meals at the Club (lunch Friday – lunch Sunday), transportation between arrival/departure point and hotel

Tournament package 4: **235,00€** per person includes entry fee, 3 nights (Thursday-Sunday) bed and breakfast accommodation in double/triple rooms, dinner on arrival day, 5 meals at the Club, transportation between arrival/departure point and hotel + Player pack (t-shirt...)

In the event of a withdrawal from the tournament fees will be reimbursed as follows:

↔ Withdrawal up to **3** weeks before the start date : fees reimbursed in full, (less bank charges).

↔ Withdrawal between **3** weeks and **1** week before the start date : 50% of fees reimbursed, (less bank charges).

✤ Withdrawal 1 week or less before the start date : reimbursement at the discretion of the tournament organiser.

TRANSPORT

Players and officials will be picked-up and dropped off at Zagreb Airport and Main train station (international Zagreb rail station). Please note that transportation will be organized only for those taking packages 2-5. *Hotel is 8min of walking from club.*

PENALTIES

The following penalties will apply, in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines, Section E.4.a, and E.4.b & E.4.c:

E.4.a) If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office within two days after the final day of the tournament (email: esf@europeansquash.com; fax +44 1424 202463). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

E.4.b) If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament (email: esf@europeansquash.com; fax +44 1424 202463). The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; and must cover the date of the relevant tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.



E.4.c) If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches, he/she will receive zero points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
